Instructions for Buying Passes

1. Go to <https://www.skiroundtop.com>
2. Click on "Buy Online"
3. From drop down menu, click on "Night Club Cards"
4. On left side, click under "Purchase Online"
5. Type Club Name: 23406
6. Type Password: CV
7. Click "Login"
8. Click on "See Available Items"
9. Select items and add to cart
10. Purchase Items
11. Sign Online Waiver

Be prepared to upload a photo during the online purchase process for anyone buying a pass. Uploading a photo online will keep you from having to wait in line to get your pass printed at the start of the season. People who upload photos online will have their passes mailed directly to their home addresses.

Behavior Contract

Participation in the Good Hope Ski and Snowboard Club is a privilege. As a result, students are expected to follow all school rules and behave in a way that reflects positively on Good Hope Middle School. In addition, the students are expected to follow all of the rules posted at Roundtop Mountain Resort to ensure a safe visit. Roundtop staff does have the right to take Night Club Cards and Season Passes from students who are not following safety rules. This would result in the student being unable to participate in the Good Hope Ski and Snowboard Club. In addition, Roundtop and Good Hope do not refund the cost of the pass or bus transportation. In addition, a failure to follow ski club rules will result in no longer being allowed to participate in the club for the duration of the visits to the mountain.

Students must do the following in order to participate in Good Hope Ski and Snowboard Club:

1. Follow all school rules for proper behavior.
2. Follow all rules for appropriate bus behavior.
3. Follow all Roundtop rules for mountain safety.
4. Come to school prepared for skiing or snowboarding on the specified days.
5. Arrange a ride to school and a ride home from school on specified days.
6. Be ready to depart from Good Hope at 3:00pm.
7. Check in with a designated staff member in the lodge between 6 and 7pm on every visit.
8. Report back to the bus by 8:30pm (failure to comply even once can result in loss of club membership).
9. Pick a partner to ski or snowboard with - no one goes alone.

Failure to follow rules one time will result in a warning. A second time will result in the student losing the privilege of participating in the club.
