When we spoke with Ms. Garza, we learned that many of the students are still unable to occupy their homes which were either damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Harvey. Ms. Garza expressed their sincere gratitude for the school supplies and toiletry products. Eagle View students are proud to have contributed to their need for these items.

On October 18, 2017, several Volunteen students met a representative, Todd Nester, from Bobby Rahal Automotive Group, Mechanicsburg, PA, at The UPS Store in Hampden Centre. These EV students had packaged and labeled all the boxes to send to Galena Park Middle School.
